

POLICIES, RULES & REMINDERS

- A non-refundable deposit of \$50 is required for all bookings. Remainder can be paid anytime, and is due by the day of the event.
- Online payment or cash only, no checks.
- Cancellations for extreme weather conditions or cancellations by Hidden Haven will result in a FULL refund - deposit included. Option to reschedule with the same deposit, if available.
- Damages to property or facility will be the responsibility of the person booking the event.
- Alcohol, smoking, and pets are strictly prohibited.
- Please remain in designated event areas.
- Every attendee, regardless of participation level, must sign a liability waiver.
- Please remember that Hidden Haven Farm is a working farm. Be respectful of the animals and their habitats.
- Please dress appropriately for weather conditions, farm terrain and event activities.
- No climbing on tractors, equipment, trees, fences etc.
- Please be aware that exterior fences are electric. Fences can be turned off by a staff member if necessary for the safety of our guests.
- Children must be supervised at all times. Supervision of children is the responsibility of the parents and guardians in attendance. Appropriate, respectful behavior is expected of everyone at all times.
- Guests are not permitted inside the animal enclosures.
- Please respect your booking time, as others may have booked an event before or after yours.
- Bluetooth speakers are available in the picnic shelter. Named: Pyle.
- Renter is responsible for cleaning up and returning the space to the condition it was found upon their arrival, unless the party cleanup add-on was purchased.
- A first-aid kit is available inside the barn near the refrigerator. You must immediately notify a staff member of any injury or medical emergency that occurs.
- Please remind attendees to use hand sanitizers, especially after touching any animals!
